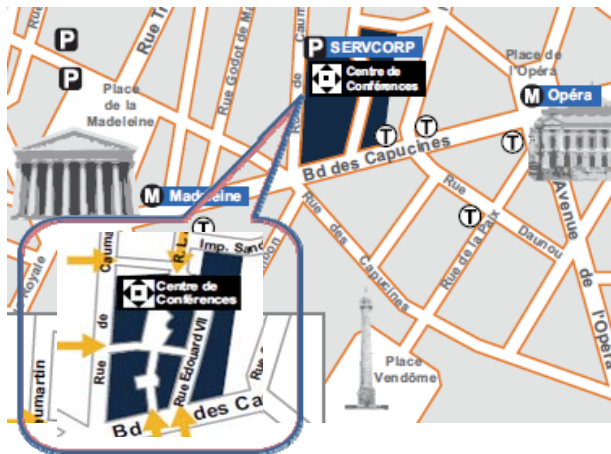

 - By Member States
 - By software

What remains to be done to realise the full potential?

- What changes are to be recommended for revision of the set of CEN-EPBD standards (“second generation” of CEN (CEN ISO) standards on energy performance of buildings)
- How to combine efforts to bring the standards to application?

Target groups:

People with an interest in the use of a set of common standards that support the implementation of EPBD, such as:

- ☞ Member States wishing to reduce costs by adopting CEN standards instead of developing separate standards at the national level (eliminating the reinvention of the wheel)
- ☞ Industries that support fair competition (comparable technical assessment and an open market)
- ☞ Building professional interested in free circulation of services throughout Europe
- ☞ National and International standardisers interested in an exchange of experience and in more transparency and efficiency in the preparation of energy performance calculation procedures
- ☞ Educational establishments whose goal is to provide universally valid training.
- ☞ Research establishments whose goal is incorporate innovative techniques in statutory calculation procedures.
